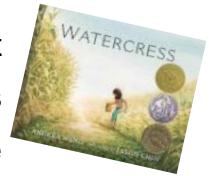




## May is AAPI Heritage Month

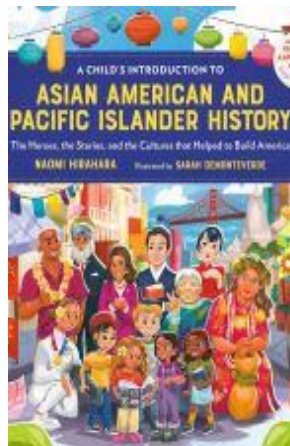

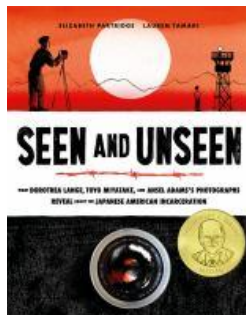
[Graphic Fiction Yan - \*American Born Chinese\*](#) - by Gene Luen
