





Picture Books Andreae - <u>Giraffes Can't Dance</u> by Giles Andreae

Gerald the giraffe is too clumsy to dance with all the other animals at the Jungle Dance, until he finds the right music. Grades K-1.



Picture Books Arena - <u>Acorn Was a Little Wild</u> by Jen Arena

Acorn is the first one off the tree, longing for adventure and new experiences, but when a squirrel buries Acorn he is forced to stay still in the dark until the exciting changes begin, and he grows into a mighty oak, though at heart he is still a little wild. Grades K-2.



Picture Books Denise - Knight Owl


by Christopher Denise After achieving his dream of becoming a knight, a small owl protects the castle from a hungry dragon. Grades 1-3.


Picture Books Doerrfeld - <u>The Rabbit Listened</u>

Picture Books Hall - <u>Red: A Crayon's Story</u>






THE BIG CHEESE Picture Books John - The Food Group Series

Picture Books Rueda - <u>Redlocks and the Three</u>



by Doug Salati


A summery picture book about mindfulness, featuring an overheated and overwhelmed canine in need of sea, sand, and fresh air. Grades K-1.
