by Peter Brown

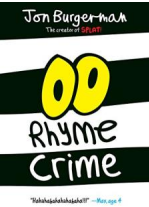
After having fun running around the house naked and wild, young Fred decides to get dressed in his parents' closet with surprising results.

by Lucy Ruth Cummins

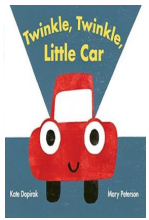
Illustrations and simple, rhyming text follow Sleepy Sheepy, who despite his name is not sleepy.

by Shannon Hale

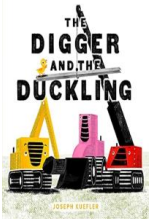

by Supriya Kelkar

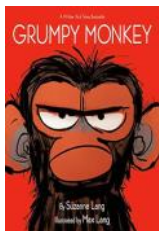

by Joseph Kuefler

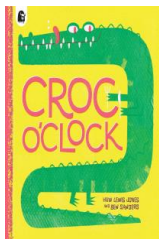
When a lost duckling waddles onto their jobsite, Digger and his friends learn how to do more than just scoop, hoist, and push--they learn to become a family.
