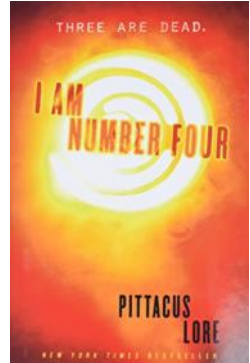
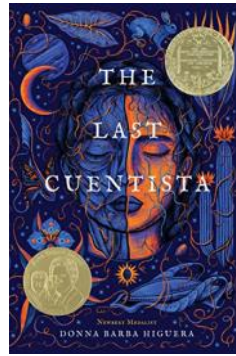

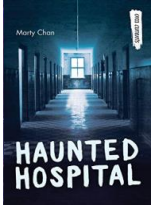

by Marty Chan

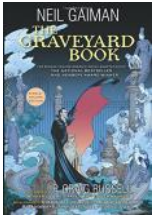
A game of pretend ghost-hunting goes awry when four Canadian teens sneak into an old, shut-down hospital with a haunted past.

by Neil Gaiman

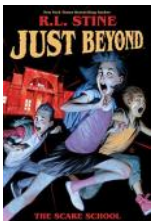

by David Arnold

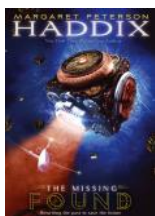

by Eoin Colfer

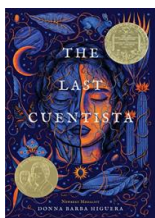

by Margaret Peterson Haddix

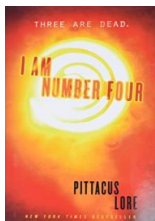

by Pittacus Lore

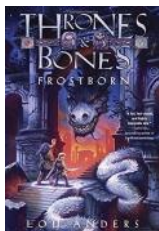

by Regina Marie Hansen

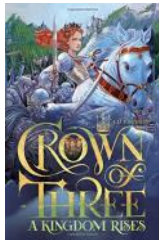
