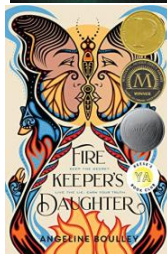
YA Ahm - **Hollow Fires** by Samira Ahmed

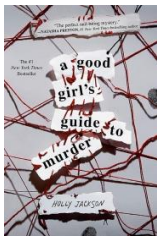
YA Her - [The Corpse Queen](#) by Heather Herrman

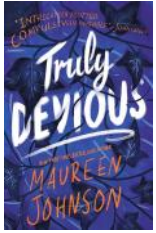

YA Jac - Monday's Not Coming

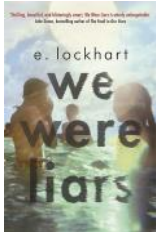
